We would like to invite you to get a jump on the Fall 2011 semester by attending one of our **BULLDOG DAYS** this summer. You will have the opportunity to tour the campus, meet with academic advisors, financial aid counselors, and register for classes. We'll treat you to lunch and give you a free Clarendon College T-shirt. Parents and guests are welcome, too.

**BULLDOG DAYS** will be held Friday, June 24, and Friday, August 5. These days will consist of informing you about CC and getting you registered for your fall classes. An informational session covering the basics of Clarendon College will start the day. Students will then be able to tour the campus, take the Accuplacer test (if needed), and register for classes. We will also have a Parent Orientation session for those parents that have concerns or questions before their students go off to college.

Please note that all students that have not taken the THEA test, have not taken an accepted alternative test, and are NOT EXEMPT from the THEA must take the Accuplacer before registering for classes. The fee to take the Accuplacer is \$49 and will be collected at the time of testing. Students must have a photo ID to be admitted into the test.

EXEMPTIONS from THEA Test:

- ACT: 23 Composite Score, Minimum of 19 on Math and English
- SAT: 1070 Composite Score, Minimum of 500 on Verbal and Math
- TAKS: 2200 on Math and English with a 3 on the Language Arts Section
