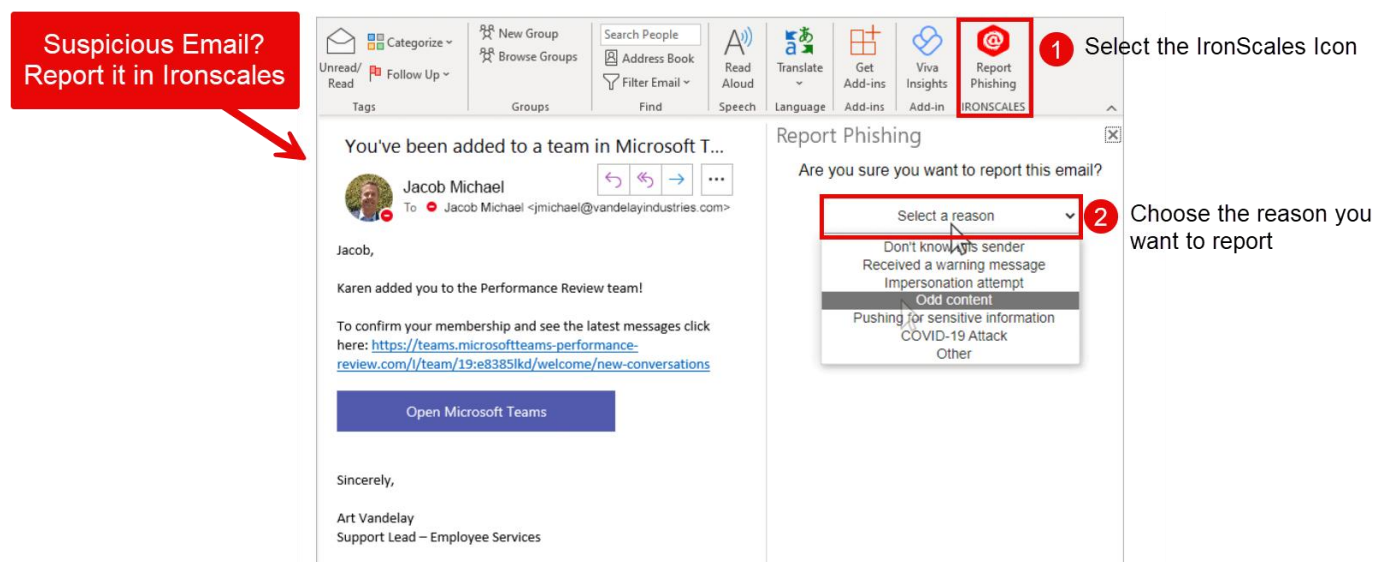


Reporting Suspicious Emails – Using IronScales in Outlook
