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ATI TEAS Pre-Admission Exam – all nursing applicants will be required to take the nursing pre-admission exam provided by Assessment Technologies Institute, LLC (ATI) in the categories of Reading, Math, Science, English & Language Usage; administered at Clarendon College. The TEAS, or Test of Essential Academic Skills entrance exam benchmark score will be a 58.7% or better for consideration. (This excludes the CNA Program or any CPR training classes). Benchmark scores are good for a period of two (2) years.

Note: Not all benchmark scores from the TEAS exam will be automatic acceptance into any of the Allied Health programs... as seats are limited. Applicants that meet the benchmark on the TEAS exam are then subject to a selection committee review and applicants are invited to attend via acceptance letters.

Expunged and Sealed Offenses: While expunged or sealed offense, arrests, tickets, or citations need not be disclosed, it is your responsibility to ensure the offense, arrest, ticket or citation has, in fact, been expunged or sealed. It is recommended that you submit a copy of the Court Order expunging or sealing the record in question to our office with your application. Failure to reveal an offense, arrest, ticket, or citation that is not in fact expunged or sealed, will at a minimum, subject your license to a disciplinary fine. Nondisclosure of relevant offenses raises questions related to truthfulness and character of the Nurse.

Orders of Non-Disclosure: Pursuant to Tex. Gov't code 5552.142(b), if you have criminal matters that are subject of an order of non-disclosure you are not required to reveal those criminal matters on form. However, a criminal matter that is the subject of an order of non-disclosure may become a character and fitness issue.

Pursuant to other sections of the Govt Code Chapter 411, the Texas Nursing Board is entitled to access criminal history record information that is the subject of an order of non-disclosure. If the Board discovers a criminal matter that is the subject of an order of non-disclosure, even if you properly did not reveal that matter, the Board may require you to provide information about any conduct that raises issues of character

Everything You Need to Know About the ATI TEAS® Exam.

PREPARE AND PASS WITH CONFIDENCE.

What is the TEAS?

The ATI TEAS, or Test of Essential Academic Skills, is a standardized test designed specifically to assess a student's preparedness for entering the health science fields. Questions are designed to test the basic academic skills you will need to perform successfully in the areas of: Reading, Math, Science, English and Language Usage. In order to be considered for admission to any of the *Clarendon College Allied Health* Programs, applicants must sit for the ATI TEAS exam with our testing coordinator HERE, in person at *Clarendon College - Pampa Campus*.

Why do I (the student) have to take the TEAS?

The ATI TEAS has been statistically proven to be a valid predictor of early nursing school success. Your score on the TEAS exam is one measure of academic preparedness that helps *Clarendon College Allied Health* personnel in considering your potential success in this rigorous, fast paced environment for acceptance into our nursing program(s).

What does the TEAS exam consist of?

The ATI TEAS test is comprised of 170 total questions that are formatted to include multiple choice, multiple select (select all that apply), fill in the blank, ordered response and hot spots. Students have 209 minutes to complete the exam (just under 4 hours).

ATI TEAS, version 7, the number of questions in each content section and subsection are as follows:

- **Reading – 45 questions (55 minutes)**
 - Key Ideas & Details – 15
 - Craft & Structure – 9
 - Integration of Knowledge & Ideas – 15
 - Unsourced Pretest Items – 6
- **Math – 38 questions (57 minutes)**
 - Numbers & Algebra – 18
 - Measurement & Data – 16
 - Unsourced Pretest Items – 4
- **Science – 50 questions (60 minutes)**
 - Human Anatomy & Physiology – 18
 - Biology – 9
 - Chemistry – 8
 - Scientific Reasoning – 9
 - Unsourced Pretest Items – 6
- **English & Language Usage – 37 questions (37 minutes)**
 - Conventions of Standard English – 12
 - Knowledge of Language – 11
 - Using Language and Vocabulary to Express Ideas in Writing – 10
 - Unsourced Pretest Items – 4

How should I prepare for the TEAS exam?

You should not HAVE to pay for study material... there is plenty that is free and even APPS you can download on your phone... your choice!

ATI, Assessment Technologies Institute, LLC, the official provider of prep material for the exam, recommends that you allow yourself plenty of time to prepare for the exam. There are a variety of prep resources available to help you study for the test – all aligned to the ATI TEAS, Version 7 and packed with thousands of practice questions based on the content and format of the actual exam.

How do I register for an "in-person" TEAS exam at an institution or testing center?

You will register with the Allied Health Department at Clarendon College-Pampa Campus Administration Assistant only. Applicants that have turned in an application to the Allied Health (Nursing) department will receive emailed information regarding any upcoming test dates, when and as they become available. Applicants will be asked to respond to that email to confirm a test date and/or can schedule by emailing nursing@clarendoncollege.edu or by calling 806-660-2014.

Once dates are available and emails have been sent out, applicants should schedule as early as possible as test dates fill up fast and are limited to availability and seating! In addition, if you need to schedule a re-test, ATI will provide a focus review based on your first exam, to help you prepare...the more time you have, the better.

In order to test, you must have an ATI account created. In the days before you come to test, create your [www.atitesting.com](https://help.atitesting.com/how-to-create-an-ati-student-account-for-teas...) account by going to <https://help.atitesting.com/how-to-create-an-ati-student-account-for-teas...> DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DAY OF TESTING. Make a note of your user name and password on the TICKET-to-TEST that you will be sent in advanced of your test date. Once on our Pampa, Tx campus, you will be directed to a computer by our on-site testing coordinator with instructions on how to proceed. NOTE: DO NOT "REGISTER" to test prior to arriving on campus.

The cost is approximately \$74.00 to be paid with credit/debit card only, the morning of your exam with the testing coordinator on site. (no cash payments will be accepted).
