Hazlewood Exemption (qualified Texas veterans only)

- At the time of entry into active duty the U.S. Armed Forces, designated Texas as Home of Record; or entered the service in Texas; or was a Texas resident (proved with Texas High School Transcript indicating graduation within one year of their enlistment)
- Exempts 150 credits of tuition & fees
- Hazlewood Legacy allows transfer to dependent child (biological, adopted, step-child) 25 or younger
- Meet the GPA requirement of the institution's satisfactory academic progress policy in a degree or certificate program as determined by the institution's financial aid policy and, as an undergraduate student, not be considered to have attempted an excessive amount of credit hours.

***** Hazlewood Exemption for veterans:

- 1. Must be accepted to Clarendon College and enrolled in classes
- 2. Complete <u>Initial Hazlewood application</u> for first semester at Clarendon College. For each sequential semester an <u>Application for Continued Enrollment</u> must be submitted.
- 3. Copy of your DD-214 member-4
- 4. Request Certificate of Eligibility Letter (required if veteran served on or after 09/11/2001)

Hazlewood Exemption – Legacy Act for dependents using transferred benefits:

- 1. Must be accepted to Clarendon College and enrolled in classes
- 2. Parent & Student complete <u>Initial Hazlewood application</u> for first semester at Clarendon College. Each sequential semester an Application for Continued Enrollment must be submitted.
- 3. Copy of parent's DD-214 member-4
- 4. Request Certificate of Eligibility Letter (required if veteran served on or after 09/11/2001)
- 5. Birth Certificate, or Marriage Certificate, or Adoption Documentation, or <u>IRS Transcript of Tax Return</u> from current or previous year indicating dependency of child, and identification of designee if applicable

◆ Hazlewood Exemption – Spouse/Dependent (Veteran is 100% disabled, KIA, MIA, or died as a result of service related injuries):

- 1. Must be accepted to Clarendon College and enrolled in classes
- 2. Student complete <u>Initial Hazlewood application</u> for first semester at Clarendon College. Each sequential semester an Application for Continued Enrollment must be submitted.
- 3. Copy of parent's/Spouse DD-214 member-4
- 4. Request Certificate of Eligibility Letter (required if veteran served on or after 09/11/2001)
- 5. Birth Certificate, or Marriage Certificate, or Adoption Documentation, or <u>IRS Transcript of Tax Return</u> from current or previous year indicating dependency of child, and identification of designee if applicable
- 6. Provide documentation verifying condition to use Spouse/Dependent Exemption
 - DD Form 1300, Report of Casualty if the Veteran died while on active duty
 - Letter from VA indicating the Veteran's death was service-related
 - VA Rating Decision Letter if the Veteran is disabled
