





We currently have a pilot program with a company that makes a smart phone app students can use to send remote messages and questions to one of our math tutors. The app is called EasyMath College App and is available for download at your smart phones app store. The app is available for both iPhone and Android devices. This is a handy study tool to have especially if you are in need of a little extra help in Algebra or Business Math. See the back of this newsletter for more information.

First Time Set-up Instructions for Students

1. Download and install the app from your app store. *(Make sure you select the EasyMath College app and not the Easy Math one)*
2. Open and sign-up
3. Select course and college
4. Enter your name and email address. *(You must sign-up with your bulldogs email account)*
5. Scroll through the features and select Done
6. Type a question
7. Take a picture of the problem your working on
8. Send the question and the picture
9. A tutor will get back to you as soon as possible
