- \*New Business
  1. Thank you, Dr. Paul for your service on the Faculty Senate, and for your help in formatting the new Faculty Senate Constitution. Dr. Paul is stepping down from her position. Dr. McIntosh is taking her place for the remainder of the year.
  2. Pathways Update—We've had 72 Care Closet requests so far, from both Clarendon and Pampa Campus. We have completed 42 Pathways trainings, including 5 face-to-face. By next week 48 people will have completed training.
  3. Faculty Lunch and Learn February—Try to do at least one in Clarendon per month. Bethany will lead one, Dr Caraway, and Dr Donahue will lead the three for Spring semester. We're looking maybe first Friday of the month, but it not decided for sure quite yet. There's also the question of whether to do this on campus... Caraway and Thompson will put together a form to vote.
  4. TCCTA Update—If interested in going, contact Wiginton or Caraway. Need to get reservation in early to get a spot in the hotel at the convention... Otherwise will probably be a couple miles away. Feb 18-20. In Frisco, just north of Dallas.
  5. Continuing Education—Kids College? Summer classes for elementary/junior high students. Maybe we could stack courses all afternoon for a week or something. Can we get people from the community to volunteer to teach various topics. Have a pottery group in town, maybe include some physical activities... Have spring semester to figure something out.
  6. Discussion over online voting for constitution amendments—We've had issues on getting information to Board in timely manner, or get form on website in timely manner. Wiginton wants to enable some form on online voting so we don't have to wait for a meeting to approve something.

For example, when early finals form came up, next meeting wasn't until this one (Dec 5<sup>th</sup>). Basically proposal is that issues that come up through a committee can be voted on electronically. Current language:
